Short reply filed on behalf of respondent No.1-State [by way of the affidavit of Deputy Superintendent of Police, Bilaspur (Yamuna Nagar)], along-with Annexures R-1 & R-2, is already available on the file and these documents are taken on the record.

Learned State counsel, on the instructions from SI Ishwar Singh, the Investigating Officer of the case, apprises the Court that the polygraph test of respondent No.8-Pulkit Mittal, the brother-in-law of the petitioner, has already been conducted and the cancellation report has also been prepared in the criminal case arisen out of the FIR bearing No.0115 dated 18.05.2022, registered at Police Station Chhachhrauli, District Yamuna Nagar, under Sections 323, 34, 376(2) (N), 506 of IPC and the same would be submitted/presented in the competent Court within one

month positively.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the above-discussed submissions as made by learned State counsel, the present petition has become infructuous and now, the petitioner would avail the appropriate and efficacious remedy, as may be permissible to her under law, before the competent Court/Forum and the instant petition be disposed of accordingly.

Resultantly, the petition in hand stands disposed of as having been rendered infructuous. However, the petitioner shall be at liberty to avail the remedy, as mentioned above.
