1. After arguing for some time, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner(s) intend to approach the respondents with the prayer that the posts which were advertised in pursuance of which the petitioners are claiming appointment, was the second advertisement and not the first and therefore, any post left unfilled in the present selection was required to be given to the other category of the physically handicapped candidate. Hence, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner(s) to approach the respondents.
2. At this stage, learned counsel further submits that in case any representation is filed by the petitioner(s), the respondents be directed to decide the same in a time bound manner.
3. Learned State counsel submits that in case any representation is filed by the petitioner(s), the same will be decided in accordance with law within a period of 8 weeks of the receipt of any such claim by passing appropriate speaking order.
4. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further.
5. Ordered accordingly.
