1. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioner prays that the petitioner intend to approach the respondent-Department for redressal of his grievance, hence, the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as aforesaid. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner will also be raising a claim for implementation of Old Pension Scheme upon the petitioner keeping in view the judgment of the Division Bench of this Court in ***CWP No.2371 of 2010*** titled as ***Harbans Lal Vs. State of Punjab and others***, decided on 31.08.2010, hence, the petitioner be given the liberty to claim the said benefit also.

2. Learned State counsel submits that in case, any representation is filed by the petitioner raising any claim, same will be decided within a period of 8 weeks of the receipt of any such claim and in case, after the decision, the petitioner is found entitled for any relief, the same will also be extended to him within a period of 4 weeks.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the present petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty as prayed for.
