1. This writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeking quashing of order dated 05.12.2017 (Annexure P-1) passed by the Deputy Commissioner (Appeals)-cum-Presiding Officer, Sri Muktsar Sahib in proceedings under the Public Premises Act, 1973, vide which the appeal filed against the order dated 31.01.2017 (Anenxure P-2) has been accepted.

2. On the last date of hearing, a written request for adjournment on behalf of learned counsel for the petitioner has been circulated and the matter was adjourned to today, specifically to be taken up at 2.45 PM and it was also observed that no further adjournment shall be granted on any ground whatsoever.
