AMAN CHAUDHARY, J.

1. Present petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No. 104 dated 07.06.2022, under Section 18 of the NDPS Act, 1985 registered at Police Station Sadar Ludhiana, District Ludhiana.
2. After arguing for some time, learned counsel submits that the petitioner is ready to surrender before the learned trial Court and prays that his application for seeking regular bail be decided within a time bound manner.
