ANOOP CHITKARA J. (ORAL)

On 16.09.2022, a Co-ordinate Bench of this court had granted interim bail by passing the following order:-

“The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered vide FIR No.78, dated 07.04.2017, Police Station Israna, District Panipat, under Sections 406 and 420 of Indian Penal Code.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in the present case challan already stands presented against co-accused and during the course of investigation, it has surfaced that only 3 persons had been defrauded in the present case and that the petitioner is willing to compensate the aggrieved persons.

Notice of motion for 28.2.2023.

Meanwhile, in the event of arrest, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal bonds and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. However, the petitioner shall join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and cooperate with the Investigating Officer and shall also abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.

The petitioner shall furnish definite information on the next date of hearing as regards compensating the aggrieved persons. If convenient, the petitioner may get along the aforesaid aggrieved persons on the next date of hearing.”

Counsel for the State submits that neither the petitioner has joined the investigation nor complied with the directions issued by this Court.

The submission of State counsel has not been disputed by petitioner's counsel on the ground that the petitioner is not contacting him.

Be that as it may and also in view of the non-compliance of order of this Court, the present petition is dismissed and interim order dated 16.09.2022 is recalled.
