Application for exemption is allowed, subject to just
exceptions.

Exemption is granted as prayed for.

The present petition is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner
in case FIR No.72 dated 13.08.2022 under Sections 326-B, 323, 379, 427 of
IPC, registered at Police Station Sadar Pathankot, District Pathankot,
Punjab (Annexure P-1).

Without adverting to the merits of the case, learned counsel for
the parties are *ad idem* that, in fact, the disharmony between the parties has

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been resolved and the complainant-Nirmala Devi has, in fact, executed an affidavit on 14.02.2023 qua the same.

In view of the above, without commenting upon the merits, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on her furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned. She shall, however, be released on the following conditions:

1. The petitioner shall declare her ordinary place of residence and the mobile number used by her.
2. She will not switch off her mobile and in case of any technical glitch, she has to give an alternate number, which will be available in her absence.
3. She will mark her presence before the SHO concerned, after every 15 days and in case the SHO refuses to mark her presence, she is permitted to make an application before the Illaqa Magistrate, concerned.
4. She will not leave the country without the prior permission of the Court, for which she will submit the copy of his passport also.

The petitioner shall abide by the terms and conditions as imposed in addition to Section 439 of Cr.P.C.

However, nothing stated above shall be construed as a final expression of opinion on the merits of the case.
