SANDEEP MOUDGIL, J (ORAL)

1. The jurisdiction of this Court under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been invoked for issuance of a writ in the nature of *Mandamus* to direct the respondents to release the retiral benefits including pension, gratuity, leave encashment, commutation of pension etc. along-with interest @ 18% per annum from the date it became due.
2. Learned counsel appearing for the respondents submits that the retiral benefits accrued to the petitioner i.e. gratuity, leave encashment, commutation of pension etc. already stands released in favour of the petitioner.
3. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, the present petition has been rendered infructuous and is disposed of, as such.
4. Ordered accordingly.
