The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226 of the Constitution of India, 1950 seeking issuance of a directions in the nature of Mandamus for directing the respondents-authorities to withdraw the Look Out Circular (LOC), issued and continued against the petitioner allegedly for last 04 years.

Status report by way of affidavit of Gopal Singh (PPS), ACP, CAW & C-Cell, Ludhiana has been filed in the Court today. A copy thereof has been handed over to the counsel for the petitioner.

As per averment contained in para No.3 of the aforesaid status report, the LOC issued qua the petitioner pursuant to the communication dated 13.04.2018 issued by the Additional Director General of Police, Internal Security Punjab stands deleted from the record of the Bureau of Investigation, Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India and the Additional Director General of Police, Internal

Security, Punjab vide its letter dated 01.12.2022 has already requested the concerned authority to cancel the LOC issued qua the present petitioner.

In view of the aforesaid specific stand taken by the respondents, the presnet petition has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of accordingly.
