1. Instant petition has been filed under Section 438

Cr.P.C. seeking grant of anticipatory bail in:-

FIR No.	Dated	Police Station	Sections
105	18.07.2023	Doraha, District Ludhiana	379 IPC and Section 21 of Mines and Minerals (Development and Regulation), Act 1957.

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2. Upon instructions received from ASI Sikander Raj, State counsel submits that some criminal cases are pending against petitioner No.1. He has specific instructions to state that all the four petitioners have joined and cooperated with the investigation and are no longer required for custodial interrogation.

3. In view of the above, but without commenting upon the merits of the allegations, petition is allowed. Order dated 08.08.2023 is made absolute, subject to satisfaction of conditions laid down under Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
