VIKAS BAHL, J.(ORAL)

This is a civil writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ, order or direction especially in the nature of certiorari quashing the illegal and arbitrary demarcation which has been carried out by respondents no.4 and 5 with respect to passage no. 477.
2. Learned counsel for the petitioner has submitted that since no action has been taken against the petitioner on the basis of the said demarcation report, thus, he seeks to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to take up all the points available to him, as per law, in any proceedings which may be instituted by the respondent authority by relying upon the said demarcation.
3. In view of the statement made by learned counsel for the petitioner, the present petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the aforesaid liberty.
