The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 189, dated 23.08.2022 registered under Sections 18 and 29 of the Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, at Police Station Bhawanigarh, District Sangrur.

Learned counsel for the State on instructions submits that pursuant to the order dated 07.09.2022 the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 07.09.2022 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
