Through this fourth petition, the petitioner seeks regular bail in case bearing FIR No.07 dated 27.03.2018, registered at Police Station Special Operation Cell, Amritsar, under Sections 21 and 29 NDPS Act.

At the outset, learned State counsel submits that out of 15 prosecution witnesses, 14 witnesses have been examined.

Faced with the situation, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that he would be satisfied, if the trial Court is directed to conclude the trial at the earliest.

In view of the above and considering the fact that the petitioner has been in custody since 27.03.2018, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the trial Court to make an endeavour to conclude the trial at the earliest.
