HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI J. (ORAL)

1. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that though the petitioners were initially appointed on part time basis starting from the year 2003 onwards but later on in the year 2014, the petitioners were working on full time basis, hence, they were entitled for the salary for the post against which they were discharging their duties.

2. Learned counsel for the petitioners further submits that similarly situated employees had approached this Court by filing CWP No.18457 of 2016 challenging the orders of the respondents by which their claim for full wages was declined wherein again a direction was given by this Court to the respondents to consider their claim and vide order dated 14.08.2017 (Annexure P-15), the benefit of full time pay has been allowed in the favour of the petitioners in CWP No.18457 of 2016, hence, the

petitioners herein are also entitled for consideration of their claim keeping in view the order passed by the respondents dated 14.08.2017 (Annexure P-15).

3. Learned counsel for the respondents submits that in case any representation is received from the petitioners giving all these details, the same will be considered in accordance with law and appropriate order on the said representation will be passed within a period of eight weeks and in case after the decision of the representation, the petitioners are found entitled for any benefit, the same will also be extended to them within a further period of four weeks.

4. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that keeping in view the statement of learned counsel for the respondents, the present writ petition may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioners to file appropriate representation along with data as well as settled principle of law.

5. Ordered accordingly.
