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Sukhwinder Singh-father and Ishmeet Kaur-mother and natural
guardian of appellant - Yashnoor Kaur have come present. Mother of the
appellant has placed on record her own duly self-attested Aadhar Card as
well as Aadhar Card of her minor daughter - Yashnoor Kaur.

The matter has been discussed. As agreed, as per statements of
parents of appellant -Yashnoor Kaur and learned counsel for the Insurance
Company (separately recorded), a sum of ₹27,00,000/- (₹ Twenty Seven
Lakh Only) over and above the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed
to the appellant in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal.

It has been stated by parents of the appellant, who is minor that
they are spending huge amount on her treatment, which is still continuing.
Hence, it is requested that they be allowed to have some amount out of the
enhanced amount awarded to the minor appellant to reimburse them for the
amount already spent on her treatment and amount, which would be required
to be spent on her treatment in future.

Accordingly, we dispose of this case with a direction to the
Insurance Company to deposit two crossed-cheques i.e. one for ₹20,00,000/-
in the name of appellant - Yashnoor Kaur daughter of Sukhwinder Singh and

another for ₹7,00,000/- in the name of Smt.Ishmeet Kaur w/o Sukhwinder Singh (mother and natural guardian of minor appellant - Yashnoor Kaur), in total ₹27,00,000/-, with the office of the Lok Adalat of the High Court on or before 15.02.2024, in compliance of this order, failing which, interest @ 9% per annum shall follow on this amount from the date of this order till payment. The concerned Officer of the Lok Adalat Branch/Office shall issue proper receipt after receiving the cheques to learned counsel/representative of the respondent-Insurance Company. He is also directed to inform parents of the appellant on their mobile No.8283887525. Parents of the appellant may collect the cheques from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order be supplied/sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the Hon'ble High Court.
