ARUN PALLI, J. (Oral):

The limited grievance that is being expressed by learned counsel for the petitioner is: that his appeal in terms of clause 16 of the policy, against the order dated 25.04.2023, passed by the First Appellate Authority is pending before the Second Appellate Authority. He submits that despite the matter being time sensitive, the appeal filed by the petitioner continues to await a decision thereon since 18.05.2023. So, much so, in the meanwhile, he submits that another order dated 03.08.2023 has also been passed against which he will avail the remedy as shall be admissible in law.

Mr. Arjun Sheoran, DAG, Punjab, upon instructions, submits that the appeal filed by the petitioner shall be taken up at the earliest and in any case would be decided within two weeks from today and an appropriate order, in accordance with law, after affording the petitioner, an opportunity of hearing shall be passed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that let the petition be disposed of, at this stage, in terms of the statement made by learned State counsel.

In the wake of the above, the petition is accordingly disposed of, in terms of the statements made by learned counsel for the parties. This Court is sanguine that the Second Appellate Authority shall consider and decide the appeal within the time stipulated above.
