Main Case

By this common order, above mentioned four writ petitions are being disposed of as all the writ petitions involve same question of law and similar facts.

In these petitions, the grievance being raised by the petitioners is that while undergoing selection process for the post of Social Education and Panchayat Officer as advertised vide advertisement No.07/2016 (Annexure P/1), certain discrepancies have occurred while conducting written examination.

Learned Senior counsel appearing for the petitioner(s) argues that certain correct options given in the answer key are not correct as per the

Census report of the Government of Haryana itself, which fact has not been

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taken into account while dealing with the objections raised by the petitioner(s) qua certain questions of the written examination and the correct options depicted in the answer key.

Similar is the grievance of the petitioners in the other connected writ petitions.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that whatever objections were received from the petitioner(s), the same were taken into consideration and keeping in view the recommendations of the experts, the decision was taken and it is only thereafter final result was declared hence, the petitioner(s) should not have any grievance.

Learned counsel for the respondents further submits that in case the petitioner(s) still have any grievance with regard to the answer key, they can file an appropriate representation with the authorities concerned and in case any such representation is filed by the petitioner(s), the same will be considered with open mind keeping in view the grounds taken to support their grievance and an appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of 06 weeks from the date of receipt of any such representation and in case after the decision of the representation, any relief is needed to be extended to the petitioner(s), the same will be extended to them within a period of further 04 weeks.

Learned counsel for the respondents further submits that keeping in view the fact that the petitioners have already undergone the selection process under the order of this Court, in case their grievance is accepted, they be given the relief, for which they are entitled for under the law.

Learned Senior counsel for the petitioner(s) submits that keeping in view the statement made by learned counsel for the respondents, the

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present petitions may kindly be disposed of having been not pressed any further with liberty to the petitioner(s) to file an appropriate representation.

Ordered accordingly.
