The petitioners have filed the present petition under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.91 dated 31.07.2022 registered under Sections 419, 420, 465, 468, 471, 170, 383, 389 and 120-B of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 at Police Station Sadar Sangrur.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Ranjit Singh, submits that in compliance with order dated 09.09.2022 passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation and are no longer required for custodial interrogation.

In view of the above facts, but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 09.09.2022 whereby the petitioners was granted interim anticipatory bail is made absolute, subject to the conditions laid down in Section 438(2) of the Cr.P.C.
