Present petition has been filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of interim regular bail for 10 days to the petitioner in FIR No.118 dated 11.06.2023, under Sections 148, 149, 114, 323, 285, 307 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 and Section 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Sadar Jagadhri, District Yamuna Nagar for attending the last rites and ceremonies of his mother.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Rajinder Kumar apprised the Court that petitioner has already been granted the concession of six hours to perform last rites of his mother.

In view of the above, no case is made out to grant bail for 10 days to the petitioner.

Accordingly, the present petition is dismissed.
