1. Through this revision petition, the correctness of the concurrent orders passed by the courts below while dismissing the petitioner's application for grant of temporary injunction restricting the defendants from laying the pipe line for the purpose of irrigating the land from their tubewell has been dismissed.

2. It has been found that the parties are co-sharers and their appears to be some mutual arrangement between the parties.

3. Both the courts have also held that, in substance, the plaintiff prays for ad-interim mandatory injunction, particularly when the partition proceedings are pending.

4. This Bench has heard the learned counsels representing the parties at length and with their able assistance perused the paper book.

5. The learned counsel representing the petitioner admits that during all these while the respondents have not taken any further steps. He prays that the trial court be directed to decide the suit, which is pending for the last six years.

6. Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, the revision petition is disposed of while requesting the court of first instance to expedite the disposal of the suit.
7. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
