The present petition has been filed for directing the respondents to consider the claim of the petitioner for appointment to the post of Station Supervisor.

Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that the petitioner competed for the post of Station Supervisor in the department of Transport in pursuance of advertisement No.7/2015. Learned counsel submits that the petitioner was placed in the waiting list in BCB category at Sr. No.2 whereas, large number of candidates have either left the job or have not joined but, the claim of the petitioner has not been considered for the appointment by the respondents despite the fact that the petitioner was eligible to be appointed against the post of Station Supervisor in BCB category keeping in view the number of posts advertised.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the representation dated 24.04.2023 (Annexure P-6) but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a direction is issued to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Pankaj Middha, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 24.04.2023 (Annexure P-6) in a time bound manner by passing an appropriate speaking order within a period of eight weeks from the receipt of copy of this order and in case, petitioner is found entitled for any benefit after the said decision, the same will be extended to the petitioner within a further period of four weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may be disposed of as having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
