1. Present writ petition has been filed seeking a prayer that the petitioners be given arrears of pay from the date of their notional promotion i.e. 26.11.1985 keeping in view the settled principle of law settled by this Hon'ble Court in CWP No.1839-2013 and CWP-3644-2019 (Annexures P-2 and P-3)
2. Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the pleading on record, it transpires that the grievance raised by the petitioners in the present petition has already been raised through a legal notice dated 21.08.2019 and subsequent reminders dated 26.06.2020 and 01.06.2023, copies of which have been annexed as Annexures P-5 to Annexures P-7.
3. Notice of motion.
4. On the asking of the Court, Mr. Gurpreet Singh, Addl. A.G. Punjab, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State and

submits that in case a the said legal notice dated 21.08.2019 (Annexure P-5) has not already been decided by respondents-State so far, the same will be considered and decided within a period of eight weeks from receipt of certified copy of this order and in case after the decision of legal notice, any benefit accrues, the same will also be extended to the petitioners within a further period of four weeks thereafter.

5. In view of the statement of learned State counsel, no further order is required to be passed and the present petition is disposed of accordingly.
