1. The petitioner prays for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the impugned order passed on 18.05.2015, whereby the petitioner's suspension period till reinstatement has been considered as leave period.

2. The petitioner was involved in a criminal case under the Prevention of Corruption Act, 1988, which resulted in his conviction vide judgment dated 03.11.2004. The appeal filed by the petitioner was allowed. He was reinstated in service but he did not join. After following the prescribed procedure, the petitioner has been dismissed from service vide order dated 28.08.2017.

3. On a Court question, the learned counsel representing the petitioner submits that he has no information about the subsequent development.

4. In these circumstances, this court does not find it appropriate to exercise the writ jurisdiction. The petitioner, if so advised, may avail an

alternative remedy.
