By way of the instant petition, the petitioner has sought the relief of anticipatory/pre-arrest bail in the criminal case arisen out of the FIR bearing No.123 dated 16.12.2019 registered at Police Station Women, Police Commissionerate Jalandhar, District Jalandhar, under Sections 406 & 498-A IPC.

2. Mr. Jagjeet Singh, Advocate, has appeared on behalf of the complainant in this case and has submitted his Power of Attorney in the Court today and the same has been placed on the file.

3. Learned State counsel, on the instructions from ASI Vijay from the above-referred Police Station, informs the Court that in compliance of the order dated 11.08.2023 as passed by the Co-ordinate

Bench, the petitioner has joined in the investigation and his custodial interrogation is not required and moreover, he is also not involved in any other criminal case.

4. In view of the afore-discussed submission as made by learned State counsel, the present petition is allowed and the relief of interim bail, as extended to the petitioner named Munish Kumar alias Munish Giri by the Co-ordinate Bench vide the said order dated 11.08.2023, is hereby made absolute.

5. However, the petitioner shall continue to join in the investigation as and when required/called upon to do so and shall also strictly abide by all the conditions as laid down in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
