1. The dispute is with regard to the receipt of compensation for the compulsory acquisition of the land with respect to share of late Sh.Nirmal Singh and Sh. Nasib Singh. The Executing Court has found that the respondents are entitled to receive the amount on the basis of the judgment passed on the ground of compromise between the parties on 06.02.1984 as well as separate Wills executed by late Sh.Nirmal Singh and Sh.Nasib Singh in favour of the respondents on 12.06.2007.

2. The Executing Court is required to execute the decree. The petitioner herein claims the amount on the basis of an alleged family settlement dated 07.04.2010, which is still to be proved. In these circumstances, there is no error in the judgment passed by the Executing Court.

3. With the aforesaid observations, disposed of.

4. All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
