Learned counsel for the petitioner argues that in the present petition, the grievance of the petitioner is that initially the merit of the petitioner was prepared after giving him 2-1/2 marks on account of experience and the petitioner was allowed to compete further in pursuance to the Common Eligibility Test for the Group C and D but unilaterally, without giving any opportunity of hearing, the marks for the experience have been withdrawn so as to reduce the merit of the petitioner which act on the part of the respondents is totally arbitrary.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has already raised the said grievance in the representation dated 25.07.2023 (Annexure P-9) but the same is still pending consideration with the respondents and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case a

direction is issued to decide the same by passing an appropriate speaking order in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Mr. Pankaj Middha, learned Additional Advocate General, Haryana, who is present in Court, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and raises no objection in deciding the representation dated 25.07.2023 (Annexure P-9) in a time bound manner and submits that an appropriate speaking order will be passed within a period of three weeks from the receipt of copy of this order and in case, petitioner is found entitled for any benefit after the said decision, the same will be extended to the petitioner within a further period of two weeks.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that keeping in view the statement of learned State counsel, the present petition may be disposed of as having been not pressed any further.

Ordered accordingly.
