1. The petitioners have assailed the order dated 09.08.2021 passed by the learned Family Court, Rewari vide which interim maintenance @ Rs.5000/- has been awarded in favour of petitioner No.2 in the proceedings under Section 125 Cr.P.C.
2. Learned counsel for the respondent submits that the matrimonial dispute has been amicably settled between the parties. Petitioner No.1 and respondent have resumed cohabitation. Petitioner No.1 along with the minor son i.e. petitioner No.2 is residing in the matrimonial house with the respondent. Furthermore, the case status on e-courts website indicates that the petition under Section 125 Cr.P.C. has been finally disposed of on 22.05.2023 and consequently, the present petition has been rendered infructuous.
3. Dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
4. As none has joined the proceedings on behalf of the petitioners, the petitioners shall be at liberty to seek revival of the petition within three months in the event, the assertions as projected hereinabove are found to be factually incorrect.
