Present writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India by the petitioner seeking issuance of writ in the nature of mandamus for directing the respondents to issue appointment letter in pursuance to the third round of counseling held on 10.05.2023 (Annexure P-16), whereby the petitioners have been allocated Department of Local Government Improvement Trust and further to permit the petitioners to join the department of Local Govt. Improvement Trust, being meritorious.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1 has joined the office of respondent No.6 during pendency of writ petition and petitioner No.2 is also ready to join with respondent No.6, but under protest.

The above fact is not disputed by learned State counsel and he submits that pursuant to the order dated 17.04.2023 (Annexure P-14) passed by Punjab Water Supply and Sewerage Board, petitioner No.1 has joined the office on 14.08.2023 during the pendency of the petition.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties and have gone through the record of the case.

In view of the aforesaid stand of the counsel for the parties, the present petition is disposed of with the directions to respondent No.4 to treat the present writ petition as representation and the same shall be decided within a period of four weeks by passing a speaking order from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
