Prayer in the present writ petition, filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India is for delivery of possession of the flat which has been allotted in draw of lots on 31.12.2014. Reference has been made to the allotment letter dated 12.02.2015 (Annexure P-3) on account of being a widow of an Ex-serviceman.

2. It is the claim of the petitioner that the flat was allotted at GGN Kherki Majra, Dhankot, Sector-102A and a total deposit of Rs.6,70,900/- has been made by the petitioner by taking a loan but possession of the flat has not been given. It is submitted that representation dated 24.03.2022 (Annexure P-6) has also been made to the respondent-Board praying for the relief of possession and also claiming interest on the amount deposited @ 12% per annum till the flat is delivered.

3. Notice of motion.

4. Mr.Deepak Sabherwal, Advocate accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-Board.
5. Keeping in view the above and as the limited relief has been sought and since the decision making is not complete, we do not feel it necessary to call upon the respondents to file reply as it would only delay the decision making process.
6. Accordingly, the present writ petition is disposed of, with direction to respondent No.1 to take a decision on the representation dated 24.03.2022 (Annexure P-6) within a period of 2 months from the receipt of certified copy of this order and pass a reasoned order.
