Although the service has duly been effected on the respondent, he has chosen not to appear.

Learned counsel for the applicant submits that the petitioner is a lady having a child of 2 ½ years and it is very difficult for her to take the child to Ludhiana to attend the case, filed by the respondent. It is also stated that there are three matrimonial matters pending at Patiala where the petitioner is residing. The husband-respondent has been attending the three cases at Patiala and there will be no difficulty, if the present case is also transferred to Patiala.

I have considered the submission of learned counsel.

Taking into the consideration the aforesaid and also finding that the petitioner is not doing any job and has no source of income and at the same time, she having a small girl child to take care of, it would be appropriate in the interest of justice that the HMA Case No.859 of 2023 filed under Section 9 of the Hindu Marriage Act, 1955 by the respondent-husband/Jaswinder Singh titled as '*Jaswinder Singh* versus *Khushpreet Kaur*' is transferred from the Court of Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Ludhiana to the Family Court at Patiala.

The case record shall be sent by the Family Court, Ludhiana and both the parties shall be issued notices by the Family Court, Patiala for further appearances.

The petitioner shall present herself before the Family Court
at Patiala on 05.01.2024.

Application stands disposed of.
