SURESHWAR THAKUR, J. (ORAL)

1. The instant writ petition is directed against the orders, which are respectively embodied in Annexures P-13, P-14, and, P-15. The above said orders are respectively rendered by the learned Collector concerned, the learned Commissioner concerned, and, by the learned Financial Commissioner Haryana.

2. Some of the aggrieved from the orders (supra), had preferred CWP-12080-2020, before this Court, and thereons, this Court had made a verdict of dismissal on 09.09.2020.

3. Be that as it may, yet the aggrieved from the above drawn verdict of dismissal by this Court, upon, the writ petition (supra), instituted Special Leave to Appeal (C) No(s). 11055-11097/2022, before the Hon'ble Apex Court. However, the Hon'ble Apex Court declined to interfere with the order of dismissal (supra), as became made by this Court. Since the

verdicts (supra), as became drawn respectively by this Court, and, by the Hon'ble Apex Court, relate to relief(s) and causes of action(s), which are similar to the ones, as are embodied in the motion (supra). Resultantly, accepting the consensus ad idem submission, as made at the bar by the learned counsels appearing for the contesting litigants concerned, that thereby the verdicts (supra) do also cover the relief(s) and causes of action(s), as propagated in the instant writ petition. The natural sequel thereof, is that, the lis enveloped in the impugned Annexures, does not require any further deliberation or any further adjudication being made thereon, as the same becomes clinchingly and conclusively determined through verdicts (supra), as became drawn respectively by this Court and by the Hon'ble Apex Court.

4. Disposed of accordingly.
