Instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to grant pay scales of Rs.480-760 w.e.f. 01.02.1981 and revised scale of Rs.1200-2040 w.e.f. 01.05.1990 at par with similarly situated junior employees in view of instructions dated 30.03.1982, Annexure P-1 and instructions dated 26.07.1991, Annexure P-2.
