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HARSH BUNGER, J. (ORAL)

1. The instant writ petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the impugned order dated 13.09.2017/19.09.2017 (Annexure P-5), whereby the petitioner has been ordered to be compulsorily retired without following any procedure.

Further prayer has been made for quashing the order dated 18.12.2017 (Annexure P-7), whereby the petitioner has been ordered to be relieved in pursuance to order dated 13.09.2017/19.09.2017 (Annexure P-5) without even waiting for order of the Appellate Authority on the statutory appeal.

2. Learned counsel for petitioner submits that the instant writ petition has been rendered infructuous as the petitioner has already retried from the services.

3. In view of aforesaid submission, the instant writ petition is dismissed as having been rendered infructuous.
