The instant writ petition has been filed for seeking compensation of Rs.50 lakhs on account of alleged negligence on the part of the respondents resulting in tragic death of Karamjeet Singh aged about 25 years due to electrocution.

The respondent-Distribution Licensee had filed a specific affidavit that compensation has been duly assessed as per Schedule IV of the Employees Compensation Act, 1923 and a sum of Rs.8,47,160/- had been deposited in favour of the petitioners.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the respondents submit that the petitioners have an efficacious alternative remedy to approach the Commissioner under the Employees Compensation Act, 1923 for redressal of their grievances.

Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the present writ petition with liberty to approach the competent Authority for redressal of grievances.

Disposed of as withdrawn with liberties as aforesaid.
