1. Through the instant petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C., the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.57 dated 14.07.2023, registered under Sections 302, 120-B IPC, at Police Station Chamkaur Sahib, District Rupnagar.
2. Vide order dated 10.08.2023, ad interim anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.
3. Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that pursuant to the aforesaid order dated 10.08.2023, the petitioner has joined the investigation.
4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Swati, submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for any further investigation.
5. I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

6. In view of the above, without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 10.08.2023 granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions envisaged in Section 438 (2) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.
