The challenge in the instant revision petition is to the order dated 22.04.2019 (Annexure P-6), passed by the Court of learned Additional Principal Judge, Family Court, Gurugram, whereby the application for amendment of the plaint, filed by the respondent, has been allowed.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that the matter has been compromised between the parties vide Memorandum of Understanding dated 05.04.2023 and on the basis of the said memo of understanding, petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act has been preferred by the parties in which first motion statement has already been recorded on 13.04.2023 and the case is now fixed for hearing on 18.10.2023 for recording joint statement of the parties on second motion.

He submits that since both the parties have already preferred petition under Section 13-B of the Hindu Marriage Act, therefore, the instant petition has been rendered infructuous.

Disposed of as having become infructuous.

However, liberty is granted to the petitioner for revival of the present petition if any cause of action still survives.
