JAGMOHAN BANSAL, J. (Oral)

1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking setting aside of order dated 21.04.2014 (Annexure P-3) whereby he has been terminated from service.

2. Learned counsel for the respondents, at the outset, submits that respondent No.1 is a society registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1860. This Court vide order dated 11.09.2023 passed in ***Reena Panta v. Union of India and Others, 2023 (3) CLR 507*** has already held that writ petition in contractual matter is not maintainable against Army Public School.

3. In the case in hand, there is dispute with respect to service of the petitioner, thus, no public interest is involved.

4. In the wake of statement of learned counsel for the respondents and order dated 11.09.2023 passed by this Court in ***Reena Panta (supra)***, the

petition stands disposed of with liberty to the petitioner to avail appropriate remedy as permissible by law.

5. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner, thus, petitioner is at liberty to move an appropriate application, if something survives.
