The instant petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing the respondent No.2 to release the vehicle of the petitioner i.e. Truck make Mahindra blazo 37 CBC3718 bearing Registration No.PB-65-AU-8722 Model 2019, which had been seized by the respondent No.2.

It was noticed in the order dated 19.09.2022 that the award had already been passed in favour of respondent No.2 and that the vehicle in question had been sold thereafter for failure by the petitioner to clear the said dues. Learned counsel for the petitioner had sought time to seek instructions in this matter. The matter was thereafter adjourned to 14.11.2022. On the said date, opportunity was granted to the petitioner to file response, if any, to the facts noticed in the order of 19.09.2022. The

matter was adjourned for today. There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner. It seems that the petitioner is no more interested in pursuing the present writ petition.

Dismissed for non-prosecution.

All the pending miscellaneous applications, if any, are also disposed of.
