Through the instant petition, the petitioner seeks anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.154 dated 11.07.2023, registered under Sections 406, 420, IPC, at Police Station Mahilpur, District Hoshiarpur.

Vide order dated 10.08.2023 passed by this Court, *ad interim* anticipatory bail was granted to the petitioner.

Learned State counsel on the instructions from ASI Gurnek Singh, submits that the petitioner has allured 26 poor ladies of the village on the pretext of facilitating them to avail loan facility and an amount of Rs.15 lakh, have been taken by the petitioner in the names of different villagers, out of which some amount was given to them and the remaining amount has been used by the petitioner after withdrawing the same through the complainant(s). He further submits that the investigation is at its initial stage and the

interrogation of the petitioner is required to unearth the such like people/gangs operating in the area and to restrain them to repeat such frauds.

I have heard the learned counsel for the parties.

As notice above, the petitioner has played fraud with 26 poor villagers and thus, the interrogation of the petitioner is required to unearth the such like people/gangs operating in the area and to restrain them to repeat such frauds.

Finding no ground in the present petition, the same is dismissed.
