1. The petitioner through instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India is seeking direction to respondent Nos.1 to 3 to issue passport to the petitioner.
2. On being confronted with the fact that application of the petitioner seeking passport was rejected in the year 2019, learned counsel for the petitioner seeks permission to withdraw the present petition with liberty to file a fresh application before the competent authority seeking issuance of passport.
3. Dismissed as withdrawn with aforesaid liberty.
4. Without expressing any opinion on merits of the case, this Court is sanguine of the fact that respondent No.3 would decide application of the petitioner considering judgment dated 14.07.2023 in *Mohan Lal @ Mohna Versus Union of India and Others; CWP-27167-2018*, passed by this Court.
