Custody certificate furnished by the State counsel is taken on record, as per which, custody of the petitioner comes out to be 1 year and 6 months.

State counsel on instructions from SI Kuldip informed the Court that the trial is progressing ahead and already 13 witnesses are examined out of total 16 witnesses on behalf of the prosecution and that the trial is going to be concluded very shortly. Faced with this situation, counsel for the petitioner made prayer that he be permitted to withdraw the present petition but direction be given to the trial Court to dispose of the case in a time bound manner.

In view of above, the present petition is hereby dismissed as being withdrawn at this stage with direction to the learned trial Court to expedite the trial and to dispose of the case finally within next 4 months of the receipt of a copy of this order and if need be, the trial Court is at liberty to prepone the trial for that purpose.
