- The petitioner has filed the present petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of anticipatory bail in the above-captioned case.

- Upon notice and after hearing learned counsel for the State, the petitioner was directed to join investigation and was granted interim anticipatory bail, vide order dated 15.09.2023, pursuant to which, affidavit dated 25.11.2023 of Gurpartap Singh Sahota, PPS, Superintendent of Police, PBI, District Amritsar (Rural) has been filed by learned State counsel in Court today. The same is taken on record.

3. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sarabjit, Police Station Majitha, District Amritsar Rural submits that in pursuance to the aforesaid order passed by this Court, petitioner has joined investigation and is no longer required for custodial interrogation.

4. In view of the above facts but without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is allowed and the order dated 15.09.2023 granting interim anticipatory bail to the petitioner is made absolute, subject to the conditions specified in Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
