The present petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.41, dated 20.02.2020, registered at Police Station City Fazilka, District Fazilka, under Sections 420 & 406 IPC on the basis of compromise (P-2).

Statements of the parties have been recorded and report dated 23.11.2022 has been received from the trial Court which shows that the compromise is genuine and voluntary. However, an observation has been made therein that one Jangir Kaur also appears to be an aggrieved person.

Learned counsel for the parties submit that Jangir Kaur is not a complainant. The complainants are respondents No.2 & 3. If at a later stage, it comes to light the said Jangir Kaur was also a complainant/aggrieved person, the order passed today may be recalled.

In view of the foregoing submissions and the reasons that the compromise is genuine and voluntary, the petition is allowed and FIR No.41, dated 20.02.2020, registered at Police Station City Fazilka, District Fazilka, under Sections 420 & 406 IPC along with all consequential proceedings having arisen therefrom, is quashed qua the petitioner.
