The applicant-petitioner, through instant application, is seeking preponement of date of hearing of the captioned writ petition.

Ms. Shweta Nahata, learned counsel for the respondents does not dispute the prayer set out in the application. Accordingly, the same is allowed and with the consent of both sides main case is taken up today itself.

1. The petitioner (minor) through his guardian, by virtue of instant petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is

seeking direction to respondent No.3 to renew passport of the petitioner without consent of father of the petitioner.

2. Ms. Shweta Nahata, learned counsel for the respondents submits that petitioner may be directed to appear before Passport Seva Kendra and submit the requisite documents. She further submits that averment made in Annexure C filed along with passport application is contrary to averments made in the writ petition, thus, competent authority would have to examine documents and averments of the petitioner.

3. Faced with this, learned counsel for the petitioner submits that petitioner would appear before Passport Seva Kendra on 01.09.2023 at 10:00 AM along with the requisite documents as well as minor child.

4. If the petitioner along with minor child and requisite documents appears before Passport Seva Kendra on 01.09.2023 at 10:00 AM, the competent authority would look into the matter and redress grievance of the petitioner. The respondent authority would keep in mind urgent need of the petitioner.

Disposed of in above terms.
