The petitioner prays for the issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari to quash the order dated 17.08.2022. He was appointed as a Substitute Computer Teacher on contractual basis on 15.09.2008. Subsequently, he was appointed as a Computer Teacher, again, on temporary basis. His request for regularization in the service was accepted on 19.06.2014. He was regularized in the service with effect from 10.06.2014, whereas, he claims regularization from 01.07.2011. Pursuant to the directions issued by this Court in a writ petition, the petitioner's claim has been considered and rejected on the ground of delay. It has been noticed that the petitioner made the representation to claim the relief, for the first time, on 11.08.2017, which is after the lapse of more than 3 years from the passing of the order of his regularization.

The learned counsel representing the petitioner does not dispute the aforesaid factual aspect.

Hence, no ground to issue the writ as prayed for is made out.

Dismissed.
