Instant writ petition has been filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondent No.2 to issue a “No Objection Certificate” (NOC) to the petitioner for appearing for interview on 13.11.2018, Annexure P-4, for the post of Senior Resident in Department of Obstetrics and Gynecology.

Upon instructions received from Sh. Gaurav Sharma, Deputy Superintendent, Director General, Health Services, Haryana, Sector-6, Panchkula, State counsel submits that NOC has been issued to the petitioner, who has completed the Senior Residency and has rejoined the services with the Government.
