By way of the instant petition, the petitioners have prayed for the quashing of the FIR bearing No.496 dated 01.06.2023 registered at Police Station HTM Hisar, under Sections 498-A, 406, 323, 354-A, 377, 506 & 354 read with Section 34 IPC.

2. Mr. Amrik Singh Narwal, learned Deputy Advocate General, Haryana, has appeared on behalf of respondent No.1 in this case in pursuance of the copy of the present petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance and on the instructions from L/ASI Kamla from the afore-referred Police Station, he apprises the Court that the investigation is still continuing and thus, the Challan has not yet been presented in the Competent Court, in connection with the criminal case under reference.

3. In view of the above-discussed submission as made by learned

State counsel, learned counsel for the petitioners seeks permission to withdraw the instant petition, at this stage, while submitting that if there need be, the petitioners would file a fresh petition for seeking the same relief, as prayed for in the present petition, at the appropriate stage, i.e after the conclusion of the investigation proceedings.

- 5. Resultantly, the petition in hand stands dismissed for having been withdrawn accordingly.
