As agreed, as per statement of the representatives of the Insurance Company and counsel for the appellants, (separately recorded today), a sum of Rs.9,50,000/- (Rupees Nine Lakhs Fifty thousand only) more, over and above, the amount awarded by the Tribunal is allowed to the appellants, in full and final settlement of the claim in this appeal. As per the statement of learned counsel for the appellants the enhanced amount would be paid to the appellant No.2 to 4, namely, Ms. Geeta minor daughter of Suresh, Ms. Archana, minor daughter of Suresh and Akash minor son of Suresh respectively.

In this regard, an affidavit has been filed by Mr. Mangat Ram son of Sh. Mehar Chand maternal grandfather of the minor stating therein that the enhanced amount may be deposited in the fixed deposit form before the MACT, Gurugram as there is no legal heirs of the deceased-Suresh except the said minor children. Copy of the said affidavit is taken on record as Mark 'A'.

We dispose of this case with a direction to Insurance Company to deposit a crossed-cheque in the sum of Rs.9,50,000/- (Rupees Nine Lakhs Fifty thousand only) in the name of appellant No.2 to 4 in equal installment in a fixed deposit form with the MACT, Gurugram on or before 24.02.2023 failing which the amount will carry 9% interest p.a. from the date of this order till the cheque is

deposited with the office of the Lok Adalat. The appellant's counsel/appellant may collect the cheque from the office of the Lok Adalat.

Copy of the order/statement be supplied /sent to the counsel/parties and file be returned to the High Court.
