GURBIR SINGH, J. (Oral)

1. Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 of Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.85, dated 01.05.2022 registered under Sections 379-B, 341, 427, 148, 149 IPC at Police Station Basti Bawa Khel, Jalandhar, District Jalandhar (Annexure P-1).

2. Briefly stated the aforesaid FIR was registered with the allegations that petitioner along with unknown person forcibly snatched Rs.2,500/- from the pocket of complainant and also damaged the car of the complainant.

3. Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been falsely implicated in the present case. He submits that the matter has been compromised between the parties.

4. Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sukjit Singh, is opposing the present petition by contending that there are seven other cases pending against the petitioner.

5. Learned counsel for the complainant submits that the matter has been compromised between the parties and a quashing petition is already filed, which is pending adjudication before the coordinate Bench of this Court.

6. Keeping in view the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties and a quashing petition has already been filed, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to the petitioner to join investigation within a week from today. On joining investigation, the petitioner be released on interim bail subject to his furnishing personal/surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer.

7. However, the petitioner shall continue to join the investigation as and when called upon to do so and shall abide by the conditions as provided under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
