The petitionerS seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.461 dated 09.06.2023 registered under Sections 406, 420 and 120-B IPC, 1860 at Police Station Barwala, District Hisar, Haryana.

The learned counsel for the petitionerS submits that in compliance of the order dated 10.08.2023, the petitioners have joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

A short reply dated 28.10.2023 by way of an affidavit of Gaurav Sharma, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Barwala, Hisar has been filed on behalf of the State by the learned counsel for the State. The same is taken on record. He on instructions admits the aforesaid fact and submits that the petitioners is no more required for further investigation in the case.

Further, the petitioners have handed over the passport in the Court today to Mr. Gaurav Sharma, DSP, Barwala, Hisar.

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In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 28.10.2023 is made absolute. However, the petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
